Flu vaccine still available at health department

Flu vaccine is still available at the health department, and it is not too late to get a shot. The cost is \$25.

Any person 6 months old or older should get vaccinated. Because it can take two weeks to develop full immunity after receiving the flu vaccine, Public Health officials urge residents to get vaccinated now.

Children 6 months to 9 years old receiving the flu vaccine who did not receive flu vaccine last year will need a follow-up booster one month after receiving the first flu vaccine.

"Every year, flu vaccine is produced that will protect against the most common influenza viruses circulating," said Roger Naylor, Southeast Health District Public Information Officer. "We are urging people of all ages to stop by the health department and get vaccinated."
