Health department has free vaccinations for eligible adults, adolescents

The Health Department is now offering a supply of free vaccines for eligible adults (regardless of insurance), and eligible adolescents who are covered by Medicaid or are uninsured or underinsured.

The available vaccines include:

For adults

- Gardasil (cervical cancer) – females only 19-26 years old
- Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) – males and females 19 years old and older
- Varicella (chickenpox) – males and females 19 years old and older
- Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (TDaP) – males and females 19-64 years old
- Pneumococcal (pneumonia) – males and females 19 years old and older, but limited to high-risk groups
- Hepatitis A and B – males and females 20 years old and older, but limited to high-risk groups

For adolescents

- Gardasil (genital warts/cervical cancer) – males and females 11-18 years old
- Meningococcal (meningitis) – males and females 11-18 years old
- Varicella (chickenpox) – males and females 11-18 years old
- Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (TDaP) – males and females 10-18 years old.
