Warmer weather and recent rains lead to an increase of mosquito activity. Local health officials are strongly urging residents to reduce mosquito populations around their home and to protect themselves against mosquito bites and the possible spread of mosquito-borne illnesses. Public Health officials recommend pouring out stagnant water in birdbaths, pet dishes, old tires and any other receptacle in which mosquitoes might breed.
