Description:	<p>With limited language resources to serve the Haitian Creole Entrants within the Southeast Health District, selected applicants will participate in two consecutive online courses, as described below.</p> <p>These online courses are designed for students who have little to no prior knowledge of Haitian Creole. At the end of this course, students will be able to comfortably navigate a conversation in Haitian Creole while engaging in the written form of the language, at an advanced beginner’s level. A total of 28 hours are included across the two courses (Elementary Haitian Creole I and II), but the dates for the second course are yet to be determined.</p>
Stipend:	Up to two \$800 awards at successful completion of each of the two courses.
Expectations:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Selected participants will complete Level 1 course successfully, including all assignments. Upon satisfactory completion, participants may progress to Level 2 coursework.-Individuals must complete satisfactory Quality Assurance (QA) review after course completion.-With appropriate QA Review, selected staff will use acquired skills to serve clients of the SEHD by providing interpretation services and/or participating in certain outreach events, as needed.-Participation in the coursework will be allowable work time, and employees and supervisors must work to schedule compensatory time or adjust schedules for after hours work, as appropriate.
Minimum Requirements:	-Must be a full-time or part-time salaried employee in good standing and have been employed by SEHD for a 6-month period prior to completion.

	<p>-Little or no prior knowledge of the Haitian Creole language is needed. A computer or smart device with a reliable internet connection is required. This course will take place ENTIRELY ONLINE on Tuesday & Thursday evenings 6:00 PM – 7:00 PM EST.</p> <p>-Must be able to start Elementary Haitian Creole Level I on 4/9/2024.</p>
